

JIM BOB TINSLEY MUSEUM WATERFALL TOURS

We offer a variety of tours including lunch and transportation for up to 6 people to the most popular and also least know waterfalls in or near Transylvania County. A full day session lasts 6-8 hours. On most tours you can see 6-8 waterfalls and several scenic sites along the way.

About Our Tours

***Basic Tour** - does not require any hard or difficult hikes. Most of the waterfalls on basic tours are roadside access - meaning they are less than 300 yards from the parking area. Basic Tours include some of the most popular and most commonly visited waterfalls in Transylvania County.*

***Adventure Tour** - requires a 3-8 mile round trip hike; these tours include some of the most popular as well as the least known waterfalls in and near Transylvania County.*

For those of you with a big appetite for adventure and hard work - we offer extreme tours.

***Extreme Tour** - requires long and difficult hikes (parts are off trail), for a view of some of the most secluded waterfalls in Transylvania County.*
